The program eliminates substandard housing through home improvement projects. Most grants include homeowner participation of 25% of repair cost due at the time of services.

Aging in Place Program Partnership Checklist

Need: Is it affecting your health and safety?

- ☐ Are you the legal owner of the property and have lived in the home for at least a year?
- ☐ Are you 55 or older and or have documented physical limitations.
- ☐ Is the home located in Moore, Hoke or Richmond County?
- ☐ Mobile homes are only eligible for ramps and steps.



Ability to pay: Based on current income and assets.

- Household income must fall below 80% of area median income (see below).
- ☐ All property taxes must be paid and up-to-date.
- ☐ Most grants include homeowner participation of 25% of repair cost due at the time of services.

Aging in Place Maximum Income Guidelines 2023

| Family Size | Moore County Annual Income | Richmond and Hoke County Annual Income |

| 1 | \$50,700 | \$38,750 |
| 2 | \$57,950 | \$44,300 |
| 3 | \$65,200 | \$49,850 |
| 4 | \$72,400 | \$55,350 |
| 5 | \$78,200 | \$59,800 |
| 6 | \$84,000 | \$64,250 |
| 7 | \$89,800 | \$68,650 |
| 8 | \$95,600 | \$73,100 |

Priority given to very low income households (less than 30% median income)

- Willingness to partner: Families must demonstrate a willingness to participate in the repairs, if able.
 - ☐ Be honest with Habitat for Humanity of the NC Sandhills about your circumstances.
 - ☐ Homeowner or family assist in the repair project when possible.
