Applications are accepted annually in August.

Homeowner Qualifications:

- We serve families with a household income between 30% and 80% of the area median income and whose monthly debt requirements are less than 40% of their monthly income, including a new mortgage.
- Habitat homebuyers must provide 200 hours of “sweat equity” and attend classes to help them succeed as homebuyers.
- Homebuyers purchase their home with a guaranteed affordable mortgage.

Aging in Place Repair Qualifications:

- At least 55 years old and/or disabled
- Have need for an exterior critical repair such as a roof or window/door replacement, HVAC or septic replacement or wheelchair ramp
- Own your home (no mobile homes except for wheelchair ramps)
- Household income below 80% county median income
- Willing to repay up to 25% of direct cost of the repair at time of repair, some grant requirements differ

- ReStore sells furniture, clothing, appliances, building materials, art and more.
- Most of the ReStore’s inventory comes from local donations.
- 100% of the proceeds are used for building materials in our community, providing enough funding to build for several families each year!
- Join our volunteer team to help process, price and display inventory. Your time helps build homes.
