Local partnerships bring outside support to Richmond County

Our Aging In Place program helps to preserve affordable housing in Richmond County. Candidates for this program own their own homes and are elderly or disabled. This year, Habitat for Humanity of the NC Sandhills will invest over \$250,000 in the county for critical repairs such as roof replacements and wheelchair ramps and an estimated \$600,000 on new home construction. Grants and forgivable loans from outside our community financially support the majority of repairs but require local funding and support as leverage.

Thank you to Dr. Wanda Wall Spivey for her leadership in a local effort to inspire local female entrepreneurs in the Leak St. community with a grant made possible through Habitat for Humanity.

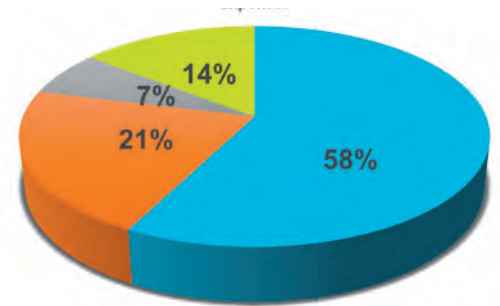
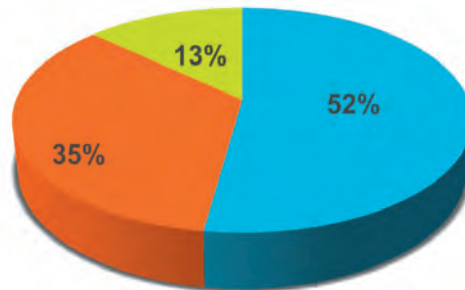

Applicant Data

The growing need for affordable housing was evident in this year's homeowner application session. Nearly 200 families submitted full applications seeking an affordable home. We accepted 15 of these families to begin their homeownership journeys with us this year.



Sandhills Habitat works with people making between 30% and 80% of the area median income to build and purchase homes with affordable mortgages. These homebuyers come from many different walks of life, but they share the dream of owning a home. We partner with homebuyers based on financial qualifications and need for housing and do not discriminate based on an applicant's race, color, sex, sexual orientation, national origin, age, religion, or handicap. We understand that the journey to owning a home can be overwhelming. We thoughtfully guide applicants through the process - from learning about personal finances, mortgages, maintenance, and much more. Our path to homeownership is an in-depth process that requires hard work, time, and dedication.

From our Homebuyer Selection Team

The cost of buying or renting a home has dramatically increased in Moore, Richmond, and Hoke counties. Habitat housing is needed now, even more than in past years. A home is so much more than shelter; it affects a family's well-being and mental stability for generations. We accepted applications for new homes, and visited families this fall as we seek to place homeowners in 15 new homes this year. We urge you to volunteer for the Homebuyer Selection Committee next year!

REPAIR PROGRAM

Carolyn's daughter, Donna learned through her church about Habitat's repair program. She promptly filled out the application for a ramp to ease mobility challenges getting her mother to and from doctors appointments. Once approved, a site visit was conducted, permits pulled, and before long a ramp was built allowing Mrs. Buchan to navigate from her porch to her car.

Sandhills Habitat is making a profound difference in our community by helping elderly homeowners and individuals with disabilities to maintain their homes with dignity through the Aging in Place Program. This initiative not only helps those age 62 and older or with documented physical disabilities reclaim their living spaces, but it also fosters a sense of pride and belonging. By addressing essential repairs and modifications, the program ensures that these valued members of our community can age in place safely and comfortably, surrounded by the support and respect they deserve.

Regina Ray paid off her loan in February of 2024. She became a Habitat homeowner on December 22, 2004, following a dedication of her West End home on December 20. What a nice Christmas present! When she applied for her home in 2003, Regina was raising her 13-month-old baby girl and 5-year-old son. Today, her daughter has a baby girl, and her son has a baby boy, so Regina is blessed with grandchildren.

Regina says that her house has been a true blessing for her family. When asked what stood out about building her home, she said the day she and her family went to work on it and found people from so many different churches in Seven Lakes working on it. They were singing, crying, and building all at once. She believes that to receive such a blessing, one must accept the help offered and "Go for it."

Regina worked for over 31 years at Sandhills Farm Life School. We all appreciate her help in caring for our children there.

Our homeowners have a great record of paying off their mortgages. To date, 60 have completely paid that obligation.
